

Tough enough to withstand very harsh conditions, Parkwood's aluminium exterior egress doors are built using superior material technology.



THE ALUMINIUM DOOR CORE




Aluminium box section down sides of door keeps it straight and square



Heavy duty aluminium extrusion top and bottom gives strength and fixing for door closers

The aluminium ribbed core gives the door a sturdy, stable and strong construction. This is joined to the face with high strength resin glue to stop delamination

Can be powder-coated to any colour for a durable finish





HIGH USAGE AREAS

- 1.6mm thick skins for durability and strong impact resistance
- Ribbed core for rigidity
- Thicker frame for wider stability and support
- Flush edges for a smoother feel with less protrusions




VENTILATION

- Angled slats to allow maximum airflow with minimal water intake
- Insect mesh option to prevent pests
- .294sm of air vent per square metre
- Powdercoated grilles to match door for a cleaner aesthetic



EGRESS TO WAREHOUSE

- Clean frame and door edge design with quality powdercoat finish
- Solid internal support for door closer and panic device installation
- Sturdy frame and door core allows a smooth opening for a fast exit
- Anti-jimmy bar option for optimal security



ENGINE & SERVICE ROOMS

- Robust design works in industrial areas smartly
- Twin fin weatherseal to bottom of door to prevent draughts and water penetration
- .294sm of air vent per square metre

DOOR TO DOOR WITH MAINFREIGHT

Parkwood was approached by Calder Stewart Construction to provide egress doors and interior doors for the new 4000m² Mainfreight building being erected in Levin, Parkwood agreed. Parkwood's range of commercial doors were ideal to reflect Mainfreight's values and reputation.

were supplied ready to be painted (to match the Mainfreight colours) and stand as a focal point against the white walls.




COMMERCIAL DOORS


Made for shopping malls, fast-food, wet and high-traffic areas, these composite doors are constructed of glass reinforced polymer, with no exposed timber.

That means they're built to resist bowing, twisting, delaminating and swelling, with superior strength and excellent hygiene properties.

- Easy to clean as door has no capping or edge recesses




